IS STUDENT ACCOMMODATION AVAILABLE ON CAMPUS?	Yes
WHAT IS THE AVERAGE COST OF ACCOMMODATION PER MONTH?	Students can be accommodated in our Academy hostel: - in a standard 3 person-room (a kitchen, toilet and a washing machine are in a separate room in the corridor which is available for all students) – the cost is 310 PLN/1 person/1 month. - in one of separate 2 twin-bedded rooms. Each two rooms come together with one bathroom and one kitchen, where you can prepare your meals together. The price is 380 – 430,00 PLN/per month/per person. Each person has to pay also 310,00 PLN as a returnable security deposit.
WHAT IS THE APPROXIMATE COST OF LIVING MONTH FOR STUDENTS? (WITH RENT)	It is about 1.200,00 PLN/per month - including accommodation and catering (cost depends on individual living expenses)
ARE THERE CATERING/RESTAURANT FACILITIES AVAILABLE ON CAMPUS?	Yes
WHAT IS THE NEAREST MAJOR CITY TO THE UNIVERSITY?	Olsztyn
WHAT IS THE DISTANCE APPROXIMATELY TO THE NEAREST CITY?	We are about 50 km away from Olsztyn

DOES THE UNIVERSITY MEET EXCHANGE STUDENTS ON ARRIVAL AT THE AIRPORT AND IS THERE A COST FOR THIS?	Students should arrive in Szczytno from the airport at their own expense. If they give us the flight number, the date, time and place of arrival (airport name), we can send a taxi from Szczytno (it will be half of the price than a taxi from Warsaw: 400 PLN Szczytno – Warsaw – Szczytno and 350 PLN Szczytno - Modlin - Szczytno)

VISAS	Required for students from outside of EU – Police Academy in Szczytno doesn't deal with visa procedure.

HEALTHCARE	EU students should bring with them their European Union Health Insurance Card and 1 document (ID) with identity photo – then healthcare is free. Students from outside the EU, before they arrive in Poland, should take out private health insurance in their own country. Those students will pay about 50,00 PLN for one appointment to see a doctor in Poland and they will get the invoice later. After that students can apply for a refund at their insurance agency in their own country.
ARE EXCHANGE STUDENTS COVERED BY POLICE ACADEMY'S INSURANCE	We do not provide personal and travel insurance. Students should take it out before they arrive in

ARE THERE ANY FEES PAYABLE TO YOUR UNIVERSITY THAT OUR STUDENTS SHOULD BE MADE AWARE OF?	Poland. For student's identity card - 5,00 PLN, accommodation and deposit fee, meals. There is possibility to have meals at our Police Academy canteen or you can prepare meals by yourselves in the Academy hostel kitchen. Canteen meal prices are: 24,02 PLN per 1 day/1 person (for 3 meals).
